Eoin Colfer on Wainfest

I've always believed the saddest thing in the world is when people are not exposed to books. I grew up with books - my Dad was a historian and my mother was part of a group that published books so there was always drama and books in our house. I remember as a child being sick once and my mother bringing home Stig of the Dump for me to read - I devoured that book and went on to try to discover as many books I could. That was the start for me.

That's the reason why one of my top priorities as Laureate na nÓg is to bring books and stories to as many people as possible. We have always been a nation of storytellers, and there are terrific stories from all around the country. I am looking forward to travelling around, meeting people and hearing their stories, and telling a few of my own.

So I'm delighted that festivals like Wainfest are there to encourage children to hear stories and to read them as well. If you can make children love stories from the earliest moment, they will go out and seek them for themselves. You inculcate in them that burning desire that I had as a child to go and find books and even more stories. And I really do believe that the child who reads makes their life infinitely easier and better.



Bookworm Babies' 1st birthday celebration


